


Maths

During term 3, we will be using all of our times tables and then applying our knowledge to written methods for division and multiplication. We will also be learning how to find the area of a shape. In term 4, we will be focusing on fractions and then starting to look at decimal numbers.

Literacy

This term we will be exploring explanation texts and writing our own that link with our science learning. After this, we will be reading Mr Stink and creating our own stories based on a moral.

In term 2, we will spend a week exploring a beautiful picture book called 'Journey' where children will focus on character and setting descriptions. Towards Easter, we will be looking at information texts and persuasive writing that link with our science learning on Living things and their habitats.



Year 4 - Term 3 & 4

Science

This term we will be starting our topic on 'States of Matter', where we will explore the water cycle and solids, liquids and gases.

Term 2 will see us moving on to 'Living things and Habitats'. We will group and classify living things using keys (local and wider environment) and we will also explore the changing world and local environments from global issues currently threatening them.

Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring explore why water is vital to us and different bodies of water, moving onto Scandinavia and making comparisons with rural Britain. Additionally, we will compare human and physical features.

RE/Life learning Our theme in life learning is dreams and goals, which ties in this term's value of resilience.

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity honing in on the life and teachings of Jesus and focusing on the key question, 'Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?' Towards Easter, we will focus on the Easter story and it's significance.

French In French, we will be learning about family members and pets, as well as exploring a traditional story and nursery rhyme.

Computing We will be focusing programming in term 3 and then learning how to create branching databases, which link with science.

PE In PE, we will be focusing on net games and Dance moving onto invasion games and swimming in term4.. We will also start swimming lessons during term 4. which will follow on into Term 5.

Art / Music

We will focus on the artist Edvard Munch and create our own versions of famous paintings that he has created. This will culminate in a special ART week at the start of Term 2 so watch this space..
