Thinking as a writer...	<p>Research local charities and create a short speech to persuade your class to raise money for it (one charity will be chosen in class from your ideas).</p> <p><b>This option will need to be prepared for Week 1 (w/b 22.04.19).</b></p>	<p>Create an information leaflet about ancient Egypt. Think about: The River Nile, Pyramids, clothing, mummies, farming.</p>	<p>Following our learning on Chinese Cinderella, write a short story set in a different culture.</p>	<p>Create a newspaper report about Howard Carter's discovery of Tutankhamen's tomb.</p>
Thinking as an artist / designer...	<p>Create a model inspired by the Ancient Egyptian architecture e.g. Pyramids.</p>	<p>Design a map of a Pharaoh's tomb. Write a set of directions to get to the centre to find the treasure. Don't forget to include hidden traps!</p>	<p>Make a mask or headdress for one of the Egyptian Gods or princesses.</p>	<p>Research the ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and create your own piece inspired by your research.</p>
Thinking as a scientist...	<p>Explore the local area. Can you find examples of a life cycle? Record your finding using photos or illustrations.</p>	<p>Plant seeds of your choice and watch as they grow. Record your observations.</p>	<p>Research an animal that goes through <b>metamorphosis</b>. Explain the process fully (you could use diagrams).</p>	<p>Research a life cycle of your choice and create a model or poster to represent it.</p>
