Thinking as a writer...	Write to your local MP about recycling and reducing waste in your community. Persuade them to take action in your area.	Write an argument for switching to a renewable source of energy.	Write a horror or fantasy story based on a supernatural nemesis/enemy.	Write a poem celebrating kindness.
Thinking as an artist...	Create a piece or a book of mindful colouring art that we can use in our class.	Draw and label a circuit involving different electrical sources or create a 3D model of a circuit.	Create a sculpture using recycled materials.	Use a local map to plan and photograph a walk to present on a poster. What key features can you find on the map and the walk? Create your own map with a key.
Thinking as a scientist...	Research the impact that plastic waste is having on one marine animal. Present in a creative way.	Present information about using technology safely to communicate with your friends in whichever form you chose – a rap, poster, presentation, poem, cartoon ...	Research the person who invented the first lightbulb and present your findings. What can we learn about resilience?	Present information about how electricity is made in whichever form you chose.
