SYNOPSIS

We will be learning all about the evolution of the British Monarchy and how it gained power and influence, including the Magna Carta, Henry VIII's determination for an heir and the impact of the British Empire.

During the final week of term 1, the whole school will be exploring Black History. Year 5 will be learning about Martin Luther King, Ruby Bridges and Delores Campbell and exploring the question: What is real leadership?

Key question 1

What makes a responsible leader?

How have responsibilities of monarchs evolved?

We will study Queen Elizabeth II and consider what her responsibilities are. We will explore different types of monarchy and consider how monarchs' roles have changed over time; for example, William the Conqueror, Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth II.

Key question 2

How did British Monarchs gain power?

How have monarchs gained and used their power to rule?

We will learn about how Monarchs rose to power, kept power and think about whether we think they were responsible leaders.

How are we responsible for our actions?

Through life learning, we will examine our rights and responsibilities in school and the wider community and how our actions can impact those around us.

Key question 3

What is real leadership?

What influence do Martin Luther King, Ruby Bridges and Delores Campbell have?

During Black History Month, we will learn about key figures both locally and globally who have had a positive impact on the world. Through this, we will explore the actions taken by Martin Luther King, Ruby Bridges and Delores Campbell and consider whether their contribution is still relevant to today's world.
