Local and Global relevance

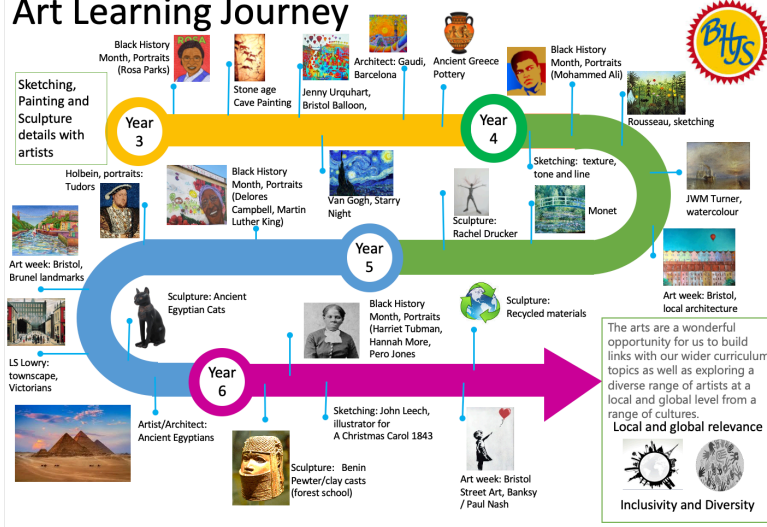
By studying a range of local, national and international artists, pupils are able to make links to a wide range of cultures across the world and how these are represented in art.
