Local and Global relevance

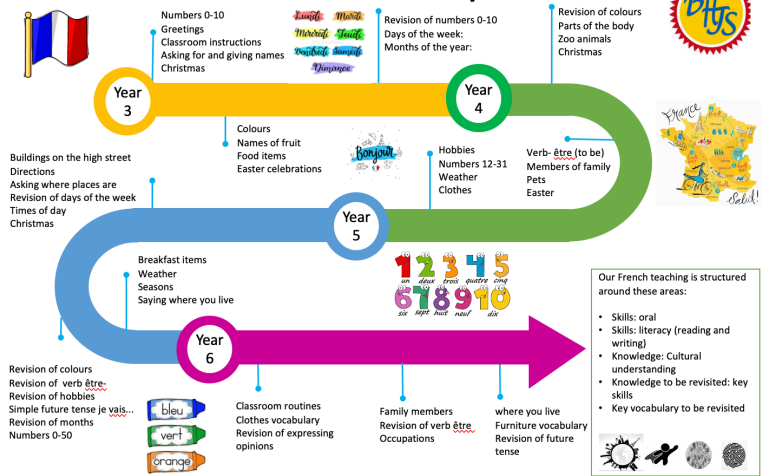
