Task Type	Option 1	Option 2	Option 3	Option 4
Thinking as a writer	Write a letter to a friend explaining what you are looking forward to in Year 5 and what you hope to achieve.	Write a newspaper report to announce one of Henry VIII's marriages. You should think about features of a newspaper report and include historical information.	Visit 'The Red Lodge Museum' in Bristol. Write a review about what you have learnt.	Write a non-chronological report on an aspect of the Tudors that interests you. You may wish to focus on the topic of: Food – what did the Tudors eat? Sport – what games did people play? Towns – what were Tudor towns like?
Thinking as an artist	Design a Tudor menu for either: - A feast at the Royal Palace or - A day in an average household.	Research the murals of the Seven Saints of St Paul's. What are they? Why have they been celebrated? You could visit these yourself and take photos.	Investigate Tudor housing and then sketch / photograph a Tudor home.	Research Tudor fashion and design an outfit for a Tudor monarch of your choice.
Thinking as a scientist	Investigate what a reversible and irreversible change is. Present your findings in your own way (e.g photos, poster).	Investigate which material would be best for an outdoor jacket and create a labelled design explaining your ideas.	Test different substances in water and investigate which dissolves the fastest or whether it dissolves at all!	Create a mixture of solids and liquids (e.g salt, paperclips, rice and water). Then, find a way to separate each of the substances. Record how you did this.
