Thinking as a writer...	<p>Write a diary entry imagining you are a child living in pre-historic Britain</p> 	<p>Create an acrostic poem about 'Responsibility'.</p>	<p>Write a short story set in pre-history and make sure you describe the setting in detail.</p> 
Thinking as an artist...	<p>Research and create a 3D model of Stonehenge.</p> 	<p>Design a poster showing how a pupil could demonstrate responsibility in school and at home.</p> 	<p>With an adult, research (or even visit) the murals of 'The Seven Saints of St Pauls' then use this as inspiration to paint your own picture of someone you admire.</p>
Thinking as a scientist...	<p>Look around your home or local community to find where different types of rocks are used. Record them (maybe take a photo) and explain why that rock was chosen for that purpose.</p>	<p>Research and find different types of soil and suggest what each one might be used for.</p> <p>Present your findings however you like (poster, map, model, PowerPoint etc).</p>	<p>Write an explanation or make a model to show how one of the types of rock are formed.</p> <p>Igneous, sedimentary or metamorphic.</p>
