<u>Further details</u>

BHJS Choir club Our school choir is a fantastic opportunity for any child who is interested in music or singing. During the sessions we will learn how to warm up, learn songs and routines. We encourage the children to sing a wide range of music from chart music to carols and hymns.

BHJS Drama club This year's drama club - led by Mrs Serle and Mr McSmythurs and supported by the wider teacher team - requires no previous experience. However, as this club will be responsible for the Christmas production on 6th December, we are looking for our budding actors and those who might like a smaller role and a responsibility for staging and props etc. to come along, join in and be courageous. Please note there will not be a drama club on Wednesday 8th November as parent consultations take part this week.

BHJS Lacemaking club Miss. Hayton is again offering Years 4,5 and 6 a chance to come and practice making a piece or 2 of Lace. If you would you like to learn a traditional textile craft, and can you count to 4 you are most welcome to participate.

Handmade Bobbin Lace is a skill that involves making pictures, motifs and cloth by weaving threads with bobbins. Not shoe laces!

The children will continue to learn basic Torchon Lace - the stitches needed to make their own project and start to learn about the patterns and fun behind making lace.

<u>Progressive Sports clubs</u> – The clubs will run for 10 weeks costing £25 per pupil (£2.50 per session) apart from the Monday and Tuesday night clubs which will only run for 9 sessions costing £22.50 due to the Inset days on 30^{th} and 31^{st} October.

We have tried to fit the club around your child's PE days so they will already be in PE kit and will not need to change for the club. However if they wish to join the club not on their PE day they will need to bring in PE kit. All are welcome to bring in additional trainers if they want to.
