As part of our Anglo Saxon and then Saxon/Viking learning (Term 2), we are going to have a special visit from Clive Pig, an international storyteller, who specialises in bringing to life all key periods in history on Thursday 12th October. The day will begin with an interactive story telling session giving the children an overview of life during the Saxon and Viking Age. Intertwined topics will be subjects such as daily life, food, clothing, conquest and life and death. Children are given the opportunity to join in with Clive's narration and further their knowledge by asking questions. The children will then take part in a 1 hr drama workshop where they will explore many of the themes discussed in the first session.
