<b>Thinking as a writer...</b>	Interview friends/ family and ask: 'What does it mean to belong to a religion?'.	Create a clearly labelled and illustrated glossary of all the terms we have been learning about in science: solvent, solute, soluble etc.	Research Greta Thunberg: create your own speech about climate change. Present this in written or video form	Write a short play script inspired by our learning on Shakespeare this term - think about our themes: tragedy, comedy, love, revenge. You could perform this with your family!
<b>Thinking as a designer...</b>	Design and make a healthy dish for your family. We would love to see photos of your success.	Design appropriate packaging for the dish that you have created. Think about our science learning on properties and materials.	Create a piece of artwork with the theme: <i>Celebrating our differences</i>	Design a t-shirt which promotes this year's Anti-bullying theme: <b>Reach Out.</b>
<b>Thinking as a geographer...</b>	Find out what 'Fairtrade' is and how it benefits farmers. If you can, visit your local supermarket with your parents. See if you can find some of the 4500 Fairtrade products on sale and record them.	Investigate and draw maps of the local area looking at how the human and physical features have changed over time.	Investigate the origin of food items in your fridge and research their air miles. Plot these on a world map – what is the impact of importing different foods?	Map the journey of a 'Fairtrade' item of food such as <b>chocolate</b> or <b>bananas</b> . Make sure you consider all of the people and places who were involved in its production.
