We have so many exciting Christmas events coming up in the next few weeks that we have compiled them all together in this letter for you. Many are supported or run by our wonderful PTA, so huge thanks to them along with our school staff for all their efforts during this busy time.

Christmas cards

We can once again dig out our Christmas post box so that they can write cards for children and staff in their own and other classes this year. The post box will be located along the main corridor throughout December and we will be asking some of our wonderful Y6 team to take on the role of Christmas postal helpers this year.
